We started our Fellowship in Annecy (France) with our stay at the clinique générale with Dr. Laurent Lafosse. One of his fellows picked us up in the hotel and during

the first day we saw many different high demanding arthroscopic surgeries like the

arthroscopic latarjet procedure, suprascapular nerve release and also reverse shoulder arthroplasty. We met his actual and past fellows and were able to see the huge amount of effort they spent for organizing the 2011 Live Annecy Shoulder Course. The next day, we joined Dr. Lafosse



in the clinic and he showed us his examination for suprascapular nerve syndrome but we also saw the excellent results 6 weeks after arthroscopic latarjet.



Then we had the great opportunity to join the Live Surgery course with 38 live operations and 25 surgeons from 9 different countries. We had the opportunity to see many different kinds of approaches and were able to join the excellent food during our stay

there.





The next stop was Nice with Prof. Pascal Boileau at the l'hôpital Archet 2. We had an excellent day in the OR seeing many different procedures like the arthroscopic bristow

procedure, the BIO RSA and demanding revision arthroplasty. Prof. Boileau discussed



and explaint us everything and shared his thoughts during surgery. In the afternoon we joined him in his clinics and could participate in his decision making process.

The next day we had a full day of OR again with demanding revision surgery,

arthroscopic and open. In the afternoon we had a scientific session and could learn a lot

in the discussion. In the evening we were invited having a delicious dinner at the seaside with the entire staff of his department and his lovely wife. The next day we joined him in the clinic and could again participate in his process of decision making and indication whilst he





responded to all our questions and we saw also the excellent outcome of his follow up patients.





Afterwards we left for Milano. We were picked up at the airport by a fellow of Dr. Castagna. The

next day we were in the Humanitas hospital with Dr. Castagna and joined many different



arthroscopic procedures including PASTA repair, revision instability surgery and SLAP repair.

In the evening we had a scientific session and could discuss his experience and research about biceps tenodesis and PASTA repair. In the evening we were invited in his house

and we were honored to meet also Prof. Randelli during a lovely dinner with very

interesting conversation. The next day he picked us up and we joined him during arthroscopic surgery, like massive cuff repair and cuff revision with arthroscopic patch augmentation. In the evening we had an excellent dinner in an italian restaurant with 23 different risottos



and his friendly staff. The next day we had the opportunity to visit Milano and had fantastic italian ice cream.





Than we took the train to Cattolica where we stayed in a very nice hotel directely at the

seaside. We were picked up the next morning by Dr. Campi who showed us the hospital, the training room with Alex shoulders, the rehab pool and the clinic. In the afternoon we joined them in the OR and saw different arthroscopic operations.

arrived there more than 7 hours later. The next morning we joined him in the OR and he was performing elbow arthroscopy
